Subject: Important Update - Changes coming to AIP Supplements

NAV CANADA is advising pilots, aircraft operators, aerodrome operators and other stakeholders of upcoming changes to the publication of AIP Supplements and the introduction of trigger NOTAM.

Moving forward, AIP Supplements related to complex closures and hazards at an aerodrome will include visual supports, including graphics, symbols, and colours, in a standardized format. These enhancements better support the development of accurate mental models of the closures and hazards, increasing safety across the industry and helping reduce or avoid incidents and accidents.

On November 30, trigger NOTAM will be introduced, which will advertise the existence of the AIP Supplement.
